Amana Orange	Heirloom (Indet - 90 days) Huge, beefsteak tomato. Big plants produce above average amounts of beautiful light-orange, fluted tomatoes that can grow to 2 lbs. or more (average 5" wide). Excellent, sweet, almost tropical fruit flavors.
Amelia	VFFFNSt TSWV (Det - 75-80 days) Outstanding disease resistance on a high-yielding plant that produces large (8-10 oz), firm tomatoes prized for their flavor. Great for salads, sandwiches, & salsas. Nice, neat plant great in containers.
Beefmaster	VFN (Indet - 80 days) One of the biggest beefsteak-types at up to 2 lbs. Nearly seedless, solid, meaty, flavorful fruit.
Beefsteak	Heirloom VF (Indet - 75 days) High yielding, old-fashioned favorite bears big, meaty 2 lb. fruits with rich, full flavor.
Beefy Boy, Park's	VFFTSt (Indet - 70 days) Huge, 12-16 oz, meaty fruit with exceptional flavor.
Bella Rosa	VFFNASStSWV (Det - 75 days) High yields of large, 10-12 oz, bright red, delicious tomatoes. In a Louisiana virus-resistant tomato trial, this ranked at the top in productivity as well as large fruit size & great flavor. Heat tolerant; does well in hot, humid areas.
Better Boy	VFNASSt (Indet - 75 days) Plump, juicy, deep red tomatoes that often weigh more than 1 lb. High yields and excellent flavor. Heavy foliage protects fruit from sunscald. Highly adaptable variety that thrives in nearly any climate. Excellent disease resistance.
Better Bush	VFN (Det - 68 days) Big 4" fruits are tasty & meaty; plants have extra sturdy stems & thick, deep green foliage. Perfect for large containers or small gardens.
BHN 444	VFF,TSWV (Det - 75 days) Bred by horticulturalists at Texas A&M & designated a Texas SuperStar tomato. Good yields of large, red, globe-shaped tomatoes. Resistant to tomato spotted wilt virus & grows well in our Texas summer heat.
Big Beef	VFFNTASSt (Indet - 73 days) Very large, smooth, round fruit weighing 9-16 oz with rich, old-fashioned flavor. Excellent disease resistance & high yields. A tough, adaptable choice in virtually any climate.
Big Brandy	"Heirloom Marriage" (Indet - 75 days) A cross of the heirlooms <u>Brandywine</u> & <u>New Big Dwarf</u> . Much higher yielding & earlier to mature than its parents with all the great heirloom flavor & fewer blemishes. 12-16 oz pink beefsteak-type fruit.
Big Bunch	VFFNTSt (Indet - 75) Produces numerous clusters of 3-4 large, 10 oz, red globe-shaped tomatoes over a long season on highly disease-resistant plants. Fruit is meaty, firm, & juicy with a sweet & tangy flavor. Use fresh or canned. (from JLL only)

Black Cherry	Heirloom (Indet - 65 days) Perfect, round cherry tomato with the sweet yet rich & complex flavor that makes black tomatoes famous. Produced in abundance on vigorous, tall plants.
Black Krim	Heirloom (Indet - 70-90 days) Unique-looking 8-16 oz, beefsteak-type tomatoes. Dark purple-red, juicy fruit with bold, smoky-sweet flavor.
Black Plum	Heirloom (Indet - 80 days) Oval, 2", deep mahogany fruit with garnet red flesh. Makes a richly-colored & delicious spaghetti sauce. (from JLL only)
Black Sea Man	Heirloom (Det - 75 days) Medium-sized (4-8 oz), slightly plum-shaped, mahogany-skinned fruit. Attractive, marbled flesh has a rich, tangy flavor. Short, potato-leafed plant does well in mid-sized containers.
Blondkopfchen ("Little Blond Girl")	Heirloom (Indet - 75-80 days) Giant clusters of golden, 1/2-1" fruit that rarely crack. One of the best tasting cherry tomatoes with an excellent, sweet flavor even kids like. Enormous yields; disease-resistant.
Brandywine (Red Potato-leaf)	Heirloom (Indet - 80 days) Legendary for its exceptional rich, succulent flavor. Large pink-red fruit up to 1 1/2 lbs. Tall vines with potato-leafed foliage.
Burpee's Big Boy	(Indet - 78 days) Wonderful aroma and rich flavor. Very large, crack-free, meaty fruit weigh 10-16 oz or more. Blemish-resistant skins.
Bush Champion II	VFFASt (Det - 65 days) Big (9-12 oz), meaty fruit with excellent flavor produced on compact, 30-36" tall, disease-resistant plant. Great sandwich tomato. High yields. "Tomato guru" Tom LeRoy's favorite!
Bush Early Girl	VFFNT (Det - 54 days) Compact plant perfect for large patio pots. Higher-yielding and earlier than most compact varieties. Huge yields of 6-7 oz meaty, red tomatoes (larger than Early Girl) with good flavor. Even more disease-resistant than the "original".
Candyland Red	(Indet - 55-60 days) Currant-type tomatoes are heavily produced in long clusters like bunches of grapes. Tiny, 1/2", 1/4 oz, red fruit are packed with supersweet, rich flavor for popping in your mouth. Neat, restrained habit makes the plant easy to manage, while exterior fruit set make harvesting a snap. The first currant tomato to win AAS honors!
Carmello	VFNT (Indet - 70 days) One of the most productive tomatoes ever bred. Large crops of crack-resistant, heavy, juicy tomatoes with exceptional flavor. Plants are widely adapted & disease-resistant.
Celebrity	VFFNTA (Det - 70 days) Exceptionally flavorful, crack-resistant, firm 8-12 oz fruit on strong vines with outstanding disease resistance.
Champion II	VFNT (Indet - 65 days) Great sandwich tomato; solid and meaty with just the right sweetness. High yields of 6-7 oz fruit. Outstanding.
Chef's Choice Orange	TMV (Indet - 75 days) AAS winner. Originated with the heirloom Amana Orange. Produces high yields of 9-12 oz orange beefsteak tomatoes that keep the same delicious, old-fashioned flavor & texture while maturing much earlier than Amana Orange.
Cherokee Carbon	"Heirloom Marriage" (Indet - 75-80 days) Purple, 10-12 oz, beefsteak-type fruit are full of rich flavor. A cross of <u>Cherokee Purple</u> & <u>Carbon</u> . Bred for improved yield, earlier maturity & fewer blemishes while keeping the old-time flavor.
Cherokee Purple	Heirloom (Indet - 80 days) Reliable producer of juicy, dusky rose/purple tomatoes averaging 8-12 oz with deep red flesh & sweet, rich flavor. Tolerant to mild drought as well as common diseases. (from JLL only)
Chocolate Cherry	Heirloom (Indet - 70 days) Produces heavy crops of 1" cherry tomatoes with unique port wine-colored flesh & skin. Thin-skinned fruit has a tangy, multi-faceted flavor. Can be picked a few days before maturity & allowed to ripen on a sunny windowsill (out of reach of hungry birds) without sacrificing flavor. (from JLL only)

Chocolate Sprinkles	Open-pollinated (Indet - 50-55 days) 1 1/2" cherry tomato that has it all--good looks, great flavor, heavy yields, & disease resistance. Bite-sized, coppery-red fruit with dark green stripes have a rich, robust flavor & rarely crack. Bears early & heavily.
Chocolate Stripes	Open-pollinated (Indet - 79 days) Heavy crop of juicy, 1-2 pound, mahogany tomatoes with dark, olive green striping. Complex, sweet, earthy tomato flavor. Delicious!
Creole	Heirloom (Indet - 78 days) Developed by LSU in 1956, this tomato thrives in hot, humid climates. The 3" tomatoes are round, firm, and juicy with a delicious tomatoey flavor with good acidity.
Early Girl	VF (Indet - 62 days) Super early variety with heavy yields of flavorful 4-6 oz fruit. Excellent performance in almost any climate.
Early Goliath	VFFNTASt (Indet - 58 days) Exceptionally early producer of extra-large harvests of big, 8 oz, sweet, red, globe-shaped fruit. Very disease resistant with continuous production. (from JJJ only)
Eva Purple Ball	Heirloom (Indet - 75 days) 4-5 oz, pinkish-purple, juicy, sweet fruit. Exceptionally disease-resistant plant does well in humid areas like ours. All-purpose tomatoes peel easily for use in sauce.
German Johnson Pink	Heirloom (Indet - 80-90 days) Potato leaf form. Mild-flavored, meaty, rough, very large (12-24 oz) fruit with deep pink skin & yellow shoulders. Low in acid. Highly rated for flavor & yield.
Genuwine	"Heirloom Marriage" (Indet - 70) A cross between the heirlooms <u>Brandywine</u> & <u>Costoluto Genovese</u> . Produces high yields of delicious 10-12 oz, slightly ribbed fruit much earlier than its parents. Continues to set fruit even in hot weather. Same old-fashioned, heirloom flavor.
Green Zebra	Heirloom (Indet - 75-80 days) Unique & delicious salad tomato. 2-4 oz fruits ripen to amber-green with darker green stripes. Light green flesh is a delicious taste treat--sweet yet zingy.
Husky Red Cherry	(Indet dwarf - 65 days) Big yields of tasty, 1" cherry tomatoes in large clusters on compact plants that continue to produce over a long season. Delicious sweet to acid balance.
Julia Child	Heirloom (Indet - 78 days) Potato-leaf plant. Produces lots of 4" deep pink, lightly fluted, beefsteak tomatoes with a robust, tomatoey flavor & firm, juicy flesh. Flavor is described as sweet & fruity balanced with acid & earthiness.
Juliet	(Indet - 60 days) Clusters of elongated, 1 oz, red fruit with full tomato flavor high in both acid & sugar. Crack-resistant. Vigorous & productive. Resistant to late blight & leaf spot.
Kosovo	Heirloom (Indet - 75-80 days) Very early for a large tomato. Huge (10-18 oz), deep pink, heart-shaped fruit. Meaty & juicy with excellent, sweet, rich flavor. Very good production.
Lemon Boy	VFNASt (Indet - 72 days) Bright, lemon yellow fruit with meaty flesh & a mild, sweet-tangy, flavor. Outyields all other golden tomatoes available. Highly adaptable plant.
Lillian's Yellow	Heirloom (Indet - 90 days) Potato-leaf variety. Large (16-20 oz), bright yellow fruit with meaty, dense interior. Rich, complex flavor unusual for a yellow tomato. Creamy taste on the tongue.
Louisiana Pink	Heirloom (Indet - 79 days) Very good yields of 3-4 oz pink, globe-shaped tomatoes. Delicious flavor. A good choice for hot, humid growing conditions like ours.
Mater Sandwich	(Indet - 75 days) Large, 10-16 oz, slightly fattened, deep red tomato with juicy, meaty flesh. One slice is enough to cover your sandwich. (from JJJ only)

Marzinera	"Heirloom Marriage" (Indet - 70-75 days) A cross of heirloom tomatoes <u>San Marzano</u> & <u>Cream Sausage</u> . Meaty, 2-3 oz, bright red paste tomatoes great for salsa, canning, and cooking. Bred for improved yield, earlier maturity, & fewer blemishes than its parents while keeping that old-time flavor.
Matt's Wild Cherry	Heirloom (Indet - 60 days) Wild variety produces deep red, extremely sweet 5/8 to 3/4" fruit on vigorous vines. Rarely bothered by diseases. From Hidalgo, Mexico.
Nepal	Heirloom (Indet - 78 days) 10-12 oz, medium-large, bright red fruit. Soft, but meaty with excellent, old-fashioned tomato flavor. Matures earlier than most large-fruited types.
Orange Zinger	FTMV (Indet -60-65 days) Sun Gold fans will love this variety! Produces high yields of 1" round, golden-orange, 2-bite morsels. Juicy & sweet with a hint of zest. Crack-resistant.
Patio	FASt (Det - 70 days) Produces large harvests of 2" round, 3 to 4 oz, flavorful, red tomatoes. Most popular variety for growing on patios, decks, courtyards, or wherever space is limited.
Paul Robeson	Heirloom (Indet - 75 days) Slightly flattened, 4" deep maroon, beefsteak-type fruits with a complex flavor that is sweet, yet tangy, with the perfect acid/sweet balance. Free of most blemishes and cracking. One of the most highly regarded black tomatoes. (from JLL only)
Perfect Flame	"Heirloom Marriage" (Indet - 65-70 days) A cross of heirlooms <u>Peron</u> & <u>Flamme</u> . Early ripening, bright orange, saladette (3 1/2-4 oz) tomato with full flavor that is a perfect balance of sweet & tart. Bred for improved yield, earlier maturity, & fewer blemishes than its parents while keeping that old-time flavor.
Pink-a-licious	VFFTMVStSWV (Det - 73 days) Widely adapted beefsteak with gourmet flavor. 5-8 oz, pinkish-crimson fruit are juicy & meaty with rich balance of sugary & tangy.
Purple Calabash	Heirloom (Indet - 75 days) 3" tomatoes shaped like Cinderella's pumpkin & deeply ribbed with lt green-purple shoulders & dk purple base. Dk purple interior tastes like a fruity Cabernet wine.
Red Cherry, Large	Heirloom (Indet - 75-80 days) 1-2" bright red fruit produced in abundance. Great, full flavor perfect for salads, fresh eating, or even canning whole.
Red Grape	Heirloom (Indet - 60 days) Heat-tolerant & disease-resistant plants produce red, elongated cherry tomatoes in long clusters. Delicious sweet, complex flavor. Vigorous, productive vines.
Roma	Heirloom VFA (Det - 75-78 days) Bright red, plum-shaped, 3" long, paste-type fruits with meaty interiors. Thick-walled & solid with very few seeds & good flavor. Compact vines yield large harvests.
San Marzano	Heirloom (Indet - 80 days) Superb flavor in slightly rectangular-shaped fruit, 3 1/2" x 1 1/2", bright red in clusters. Holds well on the vine and in storage. Extra-high solid content is perfect for canning, paste, and puree.
Sugary	(Semi-Det - 60-80 days) Super-sweet, juicy, 2 oz cherry tomatoes with reddish-pink skins. Huge yields of oval-shaped, slight pointed fruits over a long period on a more compact plant than most. (from JLL only)
Sun Gold	FT (Indet- 57 days) Premier variety of cherry tomato that ripens to a golden orange with a very sweet, fruity flavor. Produces in warm & cool conditions. Fruit matures quickly & crops heavily through the warmer months.
Sunrise Sauce	VF (Det - 55-60 days) Only orange roma/paste tomato on the market. 3-4 oz meaty fruit are easy-to-peel & have a sweet, traditional roma flavor. Small plant is ideal for smaller gardens or large containers. High yields at one time for batches of salsa or sauce.
Sweet 100	VFNT (Indet - 70 days) Huge clusters of sweet, bite-sized cherry tomatoes in abundance over a long season. High in vitamin C.

Sweet Chelsea	VFNT (Indet - 67 days) Crack-resistant, jumbo-sized cherry tomato with extra sweet taste. Vigorous, disease-resistant vine. Produces all season long.
Sweet Million	FNT (Indet - 65 days) Improved version of Sweet 100 with better disease resistance & tolerance to cracking but the same wonderful flavor & yields. Huge clusters of 1" dark red fruit on tall, vigorous plants. Matures early & continues over a long season.
Tazmanian Chocolate	(Dwarf Det - 70 days) Cross between two popular heirlooms-- <u>New Big Dwarf</u> & <u>Paul Robeson</u> . Full-sized, 5-12 oz, tomatoes produced on a compact, 3-4' tall plant perfect for containers or small gardens. Fruit ripen to deep mahogany & have a tasty, tart-sweet balance.
Terenzo	(Det - 56 days) Dwarf plant perfect for <u>hanging baskets</u> & containers. Huge yields of 1 1/4" red cherry tomatoes. Sweet, crack-resistant fruit is perfect for canning, freezing, drying, juicing, or fresh eating.
Tomatillo-Toma Verde (related to tomatoes, but not a true tomato)	Open-pollinated (60-75 days) Tart, 3 oz, green fruit with a paper-like husk. Use to make green salsa, roast to use in guacamole, or mince & add to any recipe to add a tart, lemony flavor. Isolated tomatillo plants rarely set fruit, so plant two or more for proper pollination.
Tycoon	VFFNTSWV (Det - 69-80 days) Beefsteak-type tomato with large, firm, oblate fruit that avg 9-12 oz. High yield with outstanding quality on a relatively compact plant. Heat-set ability & high tolerance to tomato yellow leaf curl virus. A Greg Grant & Tom LeRoy Texas favorite.
Viva Italia	VFFNAsT (Det - 72 days) 3 oz. pear-shaped fruits with thick, sweet flesh. Exceptionally high yields; earlier and more disease-resistant than other paste types. (from JJJ only)
Yellow Pear	Heirloom (Indet - 78 days) Miniature, bright yellow, pear-shaped, fruit with a deliciously tangy flavor. Tall plants bear large & continuous harvests. Considered by many as "garden candy".
